Recent & Current Studies

Past

- Active Brains (to test potential health benefits of a brain training website for older adults, aged between 60-85yrs old)
- ATTACK (does low dose asprin reduce the chance of first heart attack or stroke in patients with chronic kidney disease)
- Companions in Learning Disability Primary Care Consultations (investigate the role of companions (both paid and unpaid) in facilitating health communication for patients with learning disabilities during primary care consultations)
- HPValidate (to test the use of self-sampling in the NHS Cervical Screening Programme)
- **SAFER** (to explore if screening for AF in people over 70yrs leads to reduced incidence of stroke)
- SPELL (To understand treatment burden for people with multiple longterm conditions)
- **Telesafe** (looking at safety-netting advice in telephone consultations)

Present

- Athena (to explore whether taking amitriptyline can prevent the persistent pain that some people get after shingles)
- AvonCAP (looking at chest infections and worsening of asthma, COPD and heart failure)
- **COAT** (to assess the effectiveness and safety of 5 days vs 7 days of flucloxacillin for lower leg cellulitis)
- CORAL (to determine the clinical and cost effectiveness of CoQ10 added to usual care in people with heart failure managed in primary care)
- Dare2Think (to explore whether direct oral anticoagulant (DOAC) are effective at reducing thromboembolic events and vascular dementia in patients with AF)
- RAPID Test (To investigate the feasibility and value of FebriDx use for children and adults with acute URTIs in primary care, and inform the design of a future randomised-controlled trial (RCT))
- Serology Surveillance
